The Thinking Maps refers to the re-publication of the Nakba map (2015). The brooches are a proposal of a board, that enable after a general outlining of the topography - different wandering routes . These are points of friction between the object and reality, differently each time. Sometimes by choosing main roads or sometimes side ones. At times moving through new cities and at times through the empty spaces that are left. The maps represented in the brooches create a pixelated geometric schematization, which no longer exists, but remains a real object that reminds us that all this is not an illusion or a nightmare, but a reality that needs to be addressed deeply and constantly.
